

#1 Revelation 17:08 and the Beast Out of the Pit

Key Understanding: *The Beast out of the Pit. America is the Beast out of the Revelation 17:08 Pit.*

Read Revelation 17:08. It is numbered 17:08 instead of 17:8 for a reason, but it is appropriate.

Revelation 17:08 (KJV) THE BEAST that thou sawest was, and is not; and SHALL ASCEND OUT OF THE BOTTOMLESS PIT, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.

Note the word ‘pit’ in Revelation 17:08. The pit is referring to the abyss in the pure spiritual sense, but it is also describing a historical event. To reveal the prophecy of Revelation 17:08, the Lord ordained that there be an illustrious father-son combination in British political history, the Pitts. William Pitt (the father, known as “the Elder”) was born in 1708. He is a key figure in Revelation 17:08. **The Lord ordained that America’s ascension out of Pitt’s England would be integrally associated with Pitt, who was born in 1708, for the purpose of verifying and clarifying that America is the Beast in Revelation 17:08 that is arising out of the pit.**

In fulfillment of Revelation 17:08, the Lord ordained that America’s arising out of Pitt’s England was integrally associated with William Pitt.

William Pitt, the Elder



(a) William Pitt, the Elder, as Britain’s Secretary of State, became famous during the Seven Years’ War between Britain and France, as the chief prosecutor of the war, the “organizer of victory,” and the primary securer of the British Empire in North America and India. Pitt and Britain’s victory over France *literally created the circumstances* that led to the birth of the United States of America, for its by-product was the Stamp Act of 1765, which was a major cause of the colonists beginning their rebellion against England. [Pitt the Elder later became Prime Minister of England, as did his son, William Pitt, the Younger.]



The city of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, U.S., is named after William Pitt.

(b) William Pitt, after his resignation as Prime Minister of England in October 1768, studied the American situation, protested against British policy there, and actually rejoiced publicly when the American colonists resisted that policy. He is known for his powerful defense of the rights of the American colonists.

There is no man more responsible for the circumstances of England defeating France for the possession of North America, from which America could then arise, than a man named Pitt.
