#15 Six vs. Seven – 17:6-7 and 1776: The World Turned Upside Down

In the blind eyes of the Number of God 'Seven' Church of Laodicea, what is really of man, or 'six,' is often considered to be of God. It is also vice versa – what is really of God, or 'seven,' is often considered to be of man, or 'six.' The Church of Laodicea is the Church with The Spirit of '76. Thus, there is a reversal, or exchange, or trade, and confusion, seen in the fact that the Church of Laodicea is the Church with The Spirit of '76. What we can also now call this reversal and confusion of 6-7 and 7-6 of The Spirit of 1776 is The World Turned **Upside Down**.

Key Understanding: 1776 and Acts 17:6-7. The year 1776 was chosen by the Lord for American independence to also correlate with Acts 17:6-7, and the prophetic theme of The World Turned Upside Down. The World Turned Upside Down is represented by The Spirit of '76 [which will be seen more clearly in Unsealing #16, where it is explained that according to legend, the British band played The World Turned Upside Down at the Yorktown surrender on October 19, 1781].

Here is Acts 17:6-7, where we find Paul and Silas in Thessalonica, on Paul's second missionary journey.

Acts 17:6-7 (KJV) And when they found them not, they drew Jason and certain brethren unto the rulers of the city, crying, <u>These that have TURNED THE WORLD UPSIDE DOWN</u> are come hither also;

7 Whom Jason hath received: and these all do contrary to the decrees of Caesar, saying that there is another king, one Jesus.
