
Acts 17:6-7 (KJV) And when they found them not, they drew Jason and certain brethren unto the rulers of the city, crying, <u>These that have TURNED THE WORLD UPSIDE DOWN</u> are come hither also;

7 Whom Jason hath received: and these all do contrary to the decrees of Caesar, saying that THERE IS ANOTHER KING, ONE JESUS.

Key Understanding: No king but Jesus. A slogan of the American Revolution was "We have no king but Jesus," and was used by those who Turned the World Upside Down, all as a 1776 counterfeit of Acts 17:6-7. Thus, it was thought by many that with the American victory at Yorktown, The World [had been] Turned Upside Down, and essentially Jesus, not Caesar, nor the king, was now on the throne. In essence, America had become "One Nation Under God."

The error in the slogan of "We have no king but Jesus" is that, while the Lord has sovereignty over all of the earth and the fullness thereof, it is biblically impossible to establish Jesus Christ as the king over any earthly nation, for during this age, he is king over a heavenly kingdom church that is not of this world (John 18:36).

John 19:19 (KJV) And Pilate wrote a title, and put it on the cross. And the writing was, JESUS OF NAZARETH THE KING OF THE JEWS.
