#21 Six vs. Seven – The 6th and 7th U.S. Presidents: Both the 6th and 7th Presidents of the U.S. were born in '67, meaning 1767

Key Understanding: The 6th and 7th U.S. presidents. John Quincy Adams, the 6th President of the U.S. – representing Adam and the creation of man on the sixth day, and representing the number of man, six – was born on July 11, 1767, in Braintree, Massachusetts. Andrew Jackson, the 7th President of the U.S., was born on March 15, 1767, in Waxhaw, South Carolina. Jackson is considered the founder of the modern Democratic Party.

All of the Presidents of the U.S. are in prophecy. This is just the beginning of understanding the prophetic roles of John Quincy Adams and Andrew Jackson. In addition to each being birthed in '67, Adams and Jackson also opposed one another for the presidency in *both* the Election of 1824, to elect the 6th President of the U.S., and the Election of 1828, to elect the 7th President. Adams controversially defeated Jackson in 1824 – which is a story that is tied to what we are discussing – and Jackson defeated Adams in 1828.
