#70 Double Her Double – The 2nd Double: Napoleon ends the Holy Roman Empire on 8/06 of 1806, in fulfillment of Revelation 18:06



From Charlemagne to Francis II. The Habsburg family's Francis II, who succeeded his father to the throne of the Holy Roman Empire in 1792, abdicated the throne on August 6, 1806, ending the approximately 1000-year life of the Holy Roman Empire that began unofficially with the crowning of Charlemagne.

Key Understanding: The end of the Holy Roman Empire in 1806. The ending of the Holy Roman Empire on August 6, 1806 – meaning 8/06 of 1806 – was for the purpose of emphasizing its part in the fulfillment of "double her double" in Revelation 18:06.

Charlemagne

Francis II, Holy Roman Emperor (Florence, 1 February 1768 – Vienna, 2 March 1835) was the last Holy Roman Emperor, ruling from 1792 until 6 August 1806, when he dissolved the Empire after the disastrous defeat of the Third Coalition by Napoleon at the Battle of Austerlitz.

Revelation 18:06 (KJV) Reward her even as she rewarded you, and **DOUBLE UNTO HER DOUBLE** according to her works: in the cup which she hath filled fill to **HER DOUBLE**.
