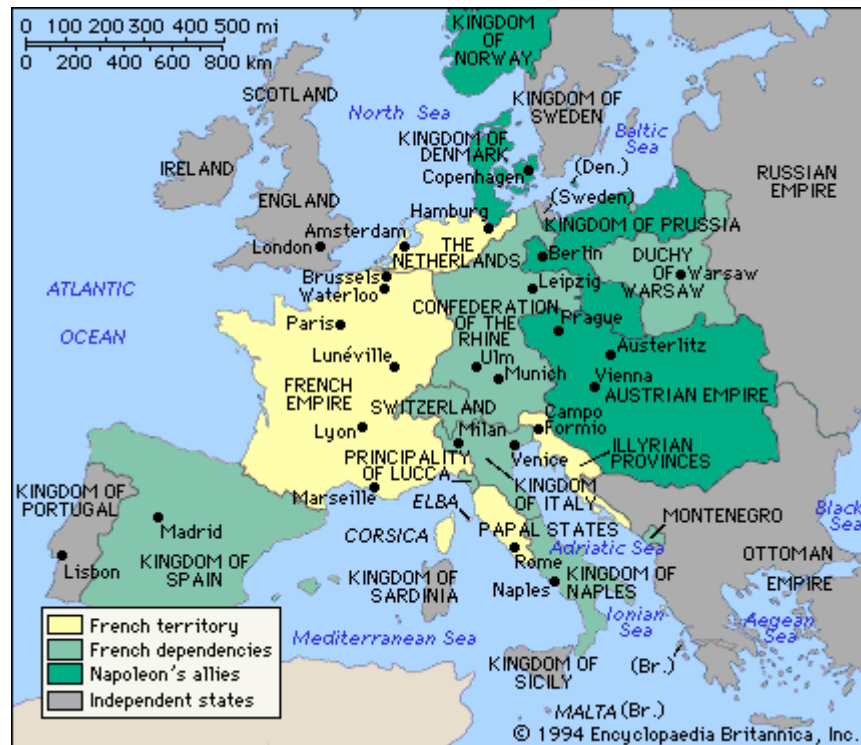


#71 Double Her Double – The West of Charlemagne’s Split defeats the East of Charlemagne’s Split

Key Understanding #1:

The West of Charlemagne’s Split defeats the East of Charlemagne’s Split. Napoleon’s France, which represents the West of Charlemagne’s Split, defeated the Habsburgs’ Austrian Empire, which represents the East of Charlemagne’s Split. An end to the Holy Roman Empire was declared on August 6, 1806.



As we summarized in Unsealing [#57](#), there were Double Splits in the unfolding history of the Roman Empire.

The First Split, which we will refer to as Diocletian’s Split, was the Division of the Roman Empire between East and West, officially implemented in 395, and which created the Greek Byzantine Empire.

The Second Split, which we will refer to as Charlemagne’s Split, was the Division of the *Holy* Roman Empire of the West, in 843, in the years after Charlemagne’s death. This split eventually created what became the nations of France and Germany.

The result of the two splits was the sandwiching of Germany between what became two of its historical rivals, Russia to the East (a result of Diocletian’s Split), and France to the West (a result of Charlemagne’s Split).

Key Understanding #2: *Double Splits and Double Her Double*. The Double Splits of the Roman Empire are a part of the picture of Double Her Double in Revelation 18:06.

Revelation 18:06 (KJV) Reward her even as she rewarded you, and DOUBLE UNTO HER DOUBLE according to her works: in the cup which she hath filled fill to HER DOUBLE.
