#81 The Daniel 2:41-43 Feet of Iron and Clay

Key Understanding: *The Feet and Toes, part of clay, part of iron, in Daniel 2:41-43, indicate division.* Just as we saw the theme of *division* with the *Legs* of Iron of the Roman Empire, we also see that same theme of *division* <u>extended to</u> the *Feet and Toes* of Daniel 2:41-43. In fact, there is a theme of *division* in each verse – in Daniel 2:41, Daniel 2:42, and Daniel 2:43 – with *IRON* vs. *CLAY* also used to show the *division*.

(i) *Division* in Daniel 2:41 is seen through THE KINGDOM SHALL BE DIVIDED.

Daniel 2:41 (KJV) And whereas thou sawest THE FEET AND TOES, part of potters' CLAY, and part of IRON, <u>THE KINGDOM SHALL BE</u> <u>DIVIDED</u>; but there shall be in it of the strength of

the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay.

(ii) *Division* in Daniel 2:42 is seen through THE KINGDOM SHALL BE PARTLY STRONG, and PARTLY BROKEN.

Daniel 2:42 (KJV) And as the TOES OF THE FEET were part of IRON, and part of CLAY, so <u>THE KINGDOM SHALL BE PARTLY STRONG</u>, and <u>PARTLY BROKEN</u>.

(*iii*) <u>Division in Daniel 2:43</u> is seen through THEY SHALL NOT CLEAVE ONE TO ANOTHER.



Nebuchadnezzar's Image in Daniel chapter 2

Daniel 2:43 (KJV) And whereas thou sawest IRON mixed with miry CLAY, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but <u>THEY SHALL NOT CLEAVE ONE TO ANOTHER</u>, even as IRON is not mixed with CLAY.
