#86 The Daniel 2:41-43 Feet of Iron and Clay – The War(s) Between the *Feet* of *Charlemagne's* Split: France vs. Hitler's Germany in World War II

Key Understanding: France the Iron winner, Germany the Clay loser. In the "War Between the Feet" of Charlemagne's Split, which is referring to World War II, France is the Iron winner, while Hitler's Third Reich Germany is the Clay loser. [Hitler's Third Reich Germany played the eventual "sandwiched" loser in both the Diocletian Split battle with Russia, and the simultaneous Charlemagne Split battle with France, since France and Russia were allies in World War II.]



France was hardly like Iron in World War II since it was occupied by Nazi Germany, but the alliance between America and France paints a different picture. The union between America and France, which we will call the *French Connection*, placed France on the winning Iron side when Germany surrendered on May 7, 1945. For the moment then, we are appropriately placing America with France in the scenario in the verses *below*.

Daniel 2:41 (KJV) And whereas thou sawest **THE FEET AND TOES**, part of potters' **CLAY**, and part of **IRON**, <u>**THE KINGDOM SHALL BE DIVIDED**</u>; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay.

Daniel 2:42 (KJV) And as the TOES OF THE FEET were part of IRON [America-France], and part of CLAY [Hitler's Germany], so <u>THE KINGDOM SHALL BE PARTLY</u> <u>STRONG</u> [America-France], and <u>PARTLY BROKEN</u> [Hitler's Germany].

Daniel 2:43 (KJV) And whereas thou sawest IRON mixed with miry CLAY, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but <u>THEY SHALL NOT CLEAVE ONE TO</u> <u>ANOTHER</u>, even as IRON is not mixed with CLAY.
