#87 The Daniel 2:41-43 Feet of Iron and Clay – The Surrender of Germany to America, France, and Russia at 2:41 a.m., May 7, 1945

The instrument of surrender was signed on May 7, 1945, at Gen. Dwight D.
Eisenhower's headquarters in Rheims by Gen. Alfred Jodl, Chief of Staff of the German Army. At the same time, he signed three other surrender documents, one each for Great Britain, Russia, and France.

Key Understanding: The surrender of Germany at 2:41 in fulfillment of Daniel 2:41.

Germany surrendered to America, France, and Russia to end the European Theatre of war in World War II at exactly 2:41 a.m., May 7, 1945, to fulfill Daniel 2:41-43 in prophecy.

This was in fulfillment of the Iron vs. Clay in both Diocletian's Split and Charlemagne's Split.

The 2:41 a.m. surrender of Germany was in fulfillment of the Iron vs. Clay in both *Diocletian's* Split and *Charlemagne's* Split.

Daniel 2:41 (KJV) And whereas thou sawest THE FEET AND TOES, part of potters' CLAY, and part of IRON, THE KINGDOM SHALL BE DIVIDED; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay.

Daniel 2:42 (KJV) And as the TOES OF THE FEET were part of IRON [America-France and Stalin's Soviet Union], and part of CLAY [Hitler's Germany], so <u>THE KINGDOM</u> <u>SHALL BE PARTLY STRONG</u> [America-France and Stalin's Soviet Union], and <u>PARTLY BROKEN</u> [Hitler's Germany].

Daniel 2:43 (KJV) And whereas thou sawest IRON mixed with miry CLAY, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but <u>THEY SHALL NOT CLEAVE ONE TO ANOTHER</u>, even as IRON is not mixed with CLAY.
