#90 The Daniel 2:41-43 Feet of Iron and Clay – Eisenhower, the Man of Iron

Eisen is the German word for *iron. Hower* means to *hew*, or *shape*. The German name for *Eisenhower* is *Eisenhauer*, and is the occupational name for "*a worker in iron.*"

Key Understanding: *Eisenhower – the Man of Iron*. The name *Eisenhower* is German and means "a worker in iron." In the "War Between the *Feet*" of *Charlemagne's* Split, referring to World War II, the Lord ordained that the *Iron winner* be led by Eisenhower, the worker in iron, defeating the *Clay loser*, Hitler's Third Reich Germany.

December 24, 1943 – General Eisenhower was named the Supreme Commander of the European invasion forces.

June 6, 1944, D-Day – The Allies invade German-held France, establishing beachheads at Normandy.

May 7, 1945, 2:41 a.m. – Germany surrenders at Reims, France, to **<u>Strong</u>** and **<u>Iron</u>**, referring to Kenneth **<u>Strong</u>** and Dwight D. <u>**Eisenhower**</u>.

Daniel 2:41 (KJV) And whereas thou sawest THE FEET AND TOES, part of potters' CLAY, and part of IRON, <u>THE KINGDOM SHALL BE DIVIDED</u>; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay.

Daniel 2:42 (KJV) And as the TOES OF THE FEET were part of IRON [EISENHOWER, representing the western Allies of America-Britain-France], and part of CLAY [Hitler's Germany], so <u>THE KINGDOM SHALL BE PARTLY STRONG</u> [Eisenhower's Chief of Intelligence Kenneth Strong, representing America-Britain-France at Germany's Surrender at 2:41 a.m., May 7, 1945], and <u>PARTLY BROKEN</u> [Hitler's Germany at 2:41 a.m., May 7, 1945].



Daniel 2:43 (**KJV**) And whereas thou sawest **IRON** mixed with miry **CLAY**, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but <u>THEY SHALL NOT CLEAVE ONE TO</u> <u>ANOTHER</u>, even as **IRON** is not mixed with **CLAY**.
