#92 The Daniel 2:41-43 Feet of Iron and Clay – The Roles of General Lucius Clay, part 1, Jodl sat in Clay's chair

General Lucius Clay. Eisenhower's headquarters at the time of Germany's surrender were at Reims, France. That is why the surrender took place at Reims. **Lucius Clay** served as deputy to General Dwight D. Eisenhower at the time of the 2:41 a.m., May 7, 1945, surrender of Germany to the Allies.


Lucius Clay was born on April 23, 1897, in Marietta, Georgia. He was the sixth and last child of Alexander Stephens Clay, who served in the U.S. Senate from 1897 to 1910, and was a direct descendant of famous U.S. statesman Henry Clay. Clay graduated from West Point in 1918, and held various civil and military engineering posts during the 1920's and 1930's. He also taught at West Point, directing the construction of dams and civilian airports. By 1942, Lucius Clay had risen to the position of the youngest brigadier general in the Army.

From March 1942 to April 1945, Clay was America's soldier in charge of defense production. As the War Department's Director of Material, Clay supervised the vast procurement activities of the Army, set production schedules, doled out military aid to the Allies, and provided the weapons with which the war was won.



German General Alfred Jodl

Jodl sits in Clay's chair. In 1945, during the time when Lucius Clay served as deputy to General Eisenhower, and at the time of the surrender of Germany to the Allies at Reims, France, German General Alfred Jodl, waiting for the call to sign the surrender agreement, sat in Clay's chair in Clay's vacant office in Reims.

Key Understanding: *Germany becomes Clay*. German General Alfred Jodl sat in Lucius Clay's chair waiting for the call to sign what became the 2:41 a.m., May 7, 1945, surrender agreement, because through that event, Jodl was going to fulfill prophecy and represent Hitler's Germany as the *Broken Clay* in Daniel 2:41-43.

Daniel 2:41 (KJV) And whereas thou sawest **THE FEET AND TOES**, part of potters' <u>CLAY</u>, and part of **IRON**, <u>THE KINGDOM SHALL BE DIVIDED</u>; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay. Daniel 2:42 (KJV) And as the TOES OF THE FEET were part of IRON [EISENHOWER, representing the western Allies of America-Britain-France], and part of <u>CLAY</u> [Hitler's Germany], so <u>THE KINGDOM SHALL BE PARTLY STRONG</u> [Eisenhower's Chief of Intelligence Kenneth Strong, representing America-Britain-France at Germany's Surrender at 2:41 a.m., May 7, 1945], and <u>PARTLY BROKEN</u> [Hitler's Germany at 2:41 a.m., May 7, 1945, with German General Alfred Jodl sitting in American General Lucius Clay's chair awaiting the call to sign the agreement].

Daniel 2:43 (KJV) And whereas thou sawest IRON mixed with miry <u>CLAY</u>, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but <u>THEY SHALL NOT CLEAVE ONE TO ANOTHER</u>, even as IRON is not mixed with CLAY.
