#112 The Short Space Kingdoms – The "ONE IS" Sixth Kingdom Roman Empire of Revelation 17:10 extends through 1917-18


[Note: One must, must, must understand the particular points of this discussion, or one will be lost in further major prophetic understandings down the road.]

Through Daniel 2:40 and our studies on the Legs of Iron, we have seen that the Roman Empire actually extended in the *East* through (a) *Diocletian's* Split to include the "Second Rome" Byzantine Empire, which ended in 1453 A.D., and then the "Third Rome" Eastern Orthodox Russian Empire, which ended in 1917-1918; the Roman Empire also extended in the *West* through (b) *Charlemagne's* Split to include the Holy Roman Empire of Charlemagne-King Otto I, of which the *eastern* part of *Charlemagne's* Split evolved to produce *both* the German Empire and Austrian Empire, both of which also ended in 1918 with the events of World War I.





Tsar Nicholas II of Russia, the last tsar of Russia, and the last tsar of the 'Roman' Romanovs. His reign prophetically ended the "one is" sixth kingdom Roman Empire of Revelation 17:10 that extended through 1917-1918.



Key Understanding: The "one is" sixth (6th) kingdom Roman Empire extends through 1917-1918. We are to see that just as Daniel 2:40 and the Legs of Iron take the Roman Empire all the way through the end of World War I, because of the inclusion of the Russian, German, and Austrian Empires, the "ONE IS" understanding of the Roman Empire in Revelation 17:10 is to be applied in the same manner, extending the Roman Empire to include the same Russian, German, and Austrian Empires. Thus, as our title says, the "ONE IS" Sixth Kingdom Roman Empire of Revelation 17:10 extends through 1917-18. [As specifically concerns the Romanovs' Russian Empire, the end of the Romanovs, whose name means Roman, is illustrating the end of one (the eastern) of the two Legs of Iron of the Roman Empire.]

Look closely at Revelation 17:10 below.

Revelation 17:9-11 (KJV) And here is the mind which hath wisdom. The seven heads are seven mountains, on which the woman sitteth.

10 And there are seven kings: FIVE [Egypt, Assyria, Babylon, Medo-Persia, Greece] ARE FALLEN, and ONE IS [the Sixth Kingdom, the Roman Empire, and as in Daniel 2:40, extending through the Byzantine, Russian, German, and Austrian Empires to the end of World War I], and THE OTHER [the Seventh Kingdom(s)] IS NOT YET COME; and when he cometh, he [the Seventh Kingdom(s)] must continue A SHORT SPACE.

11 And THE BEAST that was, and is not, even HE IS THE EIGHTH, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition.
