
## #126 The Short Space Kingdoms – Hitler's Third Reich Germany: The First 7th Kingdom that lasted "a short space"

So far, we have been spending our time on the *second* part of the fulfillment of the Double 7<sup>th</sup> Kingdoms, meaning the *Cold War* Space Race defeat of the USSR. We now are going to address the *first* part – meaning the *World War II* part – of the fulfillment of the Double 7th Kingdoms, which is that of Hitler's Third Reich lasting but "*a short space*."

Key Understanding: *Hitler's Germany lasted but a short space*. Adolf Hitler's Third Reich was supposed to last a millennium. Instead, it lasted but 12 years, *a short space*.



The Third Reich. The Nationalist Socialist German Workers Party, or Nazi Party, was the political party of the Third Reich. During the political confusion of the early 1930's, the Nazi Party made rapid gains in Germany. The term *Third Reich*, or *Third Empire*, in a rough English translation, was used to forge ties with the First Reich, the Holy Roman Empire, and the Second German Empire that began in 1871 and ended in 1918. The theme of 1000 years was attached to the Third Reich since the First Reich was deemed to have lasted 1000 years. It was all a part of the envisioned future of success for the Third German Empire.

The Third Reich refers to the Nazi government of Germany during the years 1933-1945. Hitler was named Chancellor on January 30, 1933. He would become Head of State the next year. Hitler began

to destroy the constitution and build a

dictatorship. He would only permit one party – the Nazis. Hitler desired to gain territory for the Third Reich, especially in eastern Europe. In March 1938, Germany occupied Austria and made it a part of the Third Reich, once again demonstrating the dualism that had marked the two countries for centuries. In September 1938, in the Munich Agreement, Britain and France consented to Hitler's demands to take over the German-speaking areas of Czechoslovakia. These became a part of the Third Reich as well. Germany seized the rest of Czechoslovakia in 1939, and with its invasion of Poland on September 1, 1939, World War II began.



The extension of the Third Reich before D-Day

As Berlin was being taken by Soviet forces, Adolf Hitler committed suicide on April 30, 1945. Germany signed the surrender agreement at 2:41 a.m., May 7, 1945, fulfilling Daniel 2:41-43. The Third Reich ended after the "*short space*" of only 12 years, fulfilling Revelation 17:10.

Revelation 17:10-11 (KJV) . . . and <u>THE OTHER</u> [the Seventh Kingdom, Hitler's Third Reich Germany] <u>IS NOT YET COME</u>; and when he cometh, he [the Seventh Kingdom, Hitler's Third Reich Germany] must continue <u>A SHORT SPACE</u> [1933-1945].

11 And <u>THE BEAST</u> [out of the Pit in Rev. 17:08, the United States of America] that was, and is not, even <u>HE IS THE EIGHTH</u>, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition.
