
<u>#141 The Fall of the Berlin Wall – The Moment in History of German Reunification on</u> October 3, 1990, also represented a Healing of Charlemagne's Split

On October 3, 1990, German Reunification took place. This encompassed the unification of West Germany and East Germany into a unified Germany.

Key Understanding: The 1990 reunification of a reunited Germany with France through NATO represented a <u>complete</u> healing of Charlemagne's Split. The German Reunification of October 3, 1990, represented not only a unification of West Germany with East Germany, <u>but</u> also represented a reunification of a reunited Germany with France, for now all of Germany and France would be united together as part of the NATO alliance with the U.S.-led West. In essence, this was a Healing of Charlemagne's Split.
