## #165 The World War I Second Ascension of America - Rome, Italy, and Rome, Georgia

Rome, *Georgia*, was named after Rome, *Italy*, because Rome, *Georgia*, was built on seven hills as was ancient Rome, *Italy*.

The seven hills on which ancient Rome was built were the Aventine, Caelian, Capitoline, Esquiline, Palatine, Quirinal, and Viminal. The seven hills of Rome, *Georgia*, are Clocktower Hill, Jackson Hill, Lumpkin Hill, Mount Aventine, Myrtle Hill, Blossom Hill, and Old Shorter.



The connection between Rome, Georgia, and Rome, Italy, is further emphasized by a replica of the statue of Romulus and Remus nursing from a mother wolf, a 1929 gift from the Italian dictator Benito Mussolini (pictured), and a

symbol of the original Rome. [According to Roman legend, twin brothers, Romulus and Remus, established a settlement in 753 B.C. on the Palatine Hill, one of Rome's hills overlooking the Tiber River.] The original, an example of Etruscan art, of which this statue is

an exact replica, stands in the Paolazzo dei Conservatori on Capitoline Hill in Rome, Italy.

The bronze plate on the marble base of the statue in Rome, *Georgia*, bears the following inscription:

"This statue of the Capitoline Wolf, as a forecast of prosperity and glory, has been sent from Ancient Rome to **New Rome**, during the consulship of Benito Mussolini, in the year 1929."

Key Understanding: The symbolic transfer of Rome. Benito Mussolini's gift to Rome, Georgia, of a replica of the statue of Romulus and Remus nursing from a mother wolf, while specifically meant to represent the city of Rome, Georgia, as "New Rome", is prophetically symbolic of the transfer of the mantle of the Western Roman Empire that had long ago left Rome, Italy, to New Rome, that is, America.



The gift from Mussolini is interesting in that he represents the *Broken Clay* Pact of Steel alliance of Italy with Germany in World War II, which was defeated by the *Strong Iron* United States (in the Daniel 2:41-43 War(s) Between the Feet and Toes), which had received its anointed role as the Fourth Rome as a consequence of World War I, when Woodrow Wilson was President of the United States. Wilson had married a girl from Rome.
