#206 The Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7 – The Seven Years' War (1756-1763), the "First World War"

Key Understanding: *The first world war before the First World War*. Not surprisingly, the Lord ordained a war that fulfilled Daniel 7:7 to be called the <u>Seven Years' War</u> (1756-1763). The Seven Years' War (1756-1763) would fulfill Daniel 7:7, and set the stage for Daniel 7:8.


Daniel 7:7 (*KJV*) After this I saw in the night visions, and <u>BEHOLD A FOURTH BEAST</u> [Roman Empire], dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it was diverse from all the beasts that were before it; and <u>IT HAD TEN HORNS</u>. [The Ten Horns part of Daniel 7:7 was fulfilled through the event of the Seven Years' War.]

The Seven Years' War (1756-1763) would fulfill the 'Ten Horns' part of Daniel 7:7, and set the stage for the 1776 rise of the 'Little Horn' Fifth Beast of Daniel 7:8.

Daniel 7:8 (KJV) I considered <u>THE</u> [Ten] <u>HORNS</u>, and behold, there came up among them another <u>LITTLE HORN</u> [a Fifth Beast, the United States of America], before whom there were <u>THREE OF THE FIRST HORNS</u> [England, France, and Spain, uprooted by Mexico, which was then uprooted by the United States in the 1846-1848 Mexican War] <u>PLUCKED UP BY THE ROOTS</u>: and, behold, in this horn were eyes like the eyes of man, and <u>A</u> MOUTH SPEAKING GREAT THINGS.

going into and during part of the First World War (1914-1918), called the Seven Years' War (1756-1763) the "first world war", because it was the first conflict in human history to be fought around the globe. It involved ten major powers in Europe.
