#217 The Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1 – The Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7 and the Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1

In Unsealings $\frac{\#205}{\#216}$, we discussed <u>The Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7</u>, in the Old Testament. Now we are ready to discuss <u>The Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1</u>, in the New Testament. First, Daniel 7:7 and then Revelation 13:1-2.

Daniel 7:7 (KJV) After this I saw in the night visions, and <u>**BEHOLD A FOURTH BEAST</u>** [Roman Empire], dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it was diverse from all the beasts that were before it; and <u>**IT HAD TEN HORNS**</u>.</u>



Revelation 13:1-2 (KJV) And I stood upon the sand of the sea[shore], and saw <u>A BEAST</u> <u>RISE UP OUT OF THE SEA, HAVING</u> SEVEN HEADS AND <u>TEN HORNS</u>, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.

2 And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as the feet of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority.

Key Understanding: *The ten horns*. At first glance – because the passages are so similar – one might think that the *Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1* are identical to the *Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7*. <u>They are not</u>.

To learn why the Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7 are *not* the same as the Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1, let's first focus on the *similarities* of the two passages, before we understand the *differences* between the Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7 and the Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1.
