


## #225 The Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1 – The Ten Horns are Crowned

**Key Understanding:** *The crowning of the ten horns. It is specifically written that the Ten Horns of the Revelation 13:1 Beast out of the Sea are crowned, representing kingship.*

### Revelation 13:1 Beast out of the Sea

Here is the Revelation 13:1 Beast out of the Sea, with Seven Heads and *Ten Horns*. The Ten Horns are *crowned*.

*Revelation 13:1 (KJV) And I stood upon the sand of the sea[shore], and saw A BEAST RISE UP OUT OF THE SEA, HAVING SEVEN HEADS AND TEN HORNS, and UPON HIS [Ten] HORNS TEN CROWNS, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.*



What about the Seven Heads? There is no mention of the Seven Heads being crowned.

In Revelation 13:1, **the Beast** has *seven heads that are not crowned*, and has *ten horns that are crowned*.

### Revelation 12:3 Great Red Dragon

In Revelation 12:3, we see a Great Red Dragon, meaning Satan.

Look at what is written in Revelation 12:3, in comparison to Revelation 13:1. There are Seven Heads and Ten Horns, just as there are in Revelation 13:1, but in Revelation 12:3, the Ten Horns *are not* crowned, while the Seven Heads *are* crowned.

*Revelation 12:3 (KJV) And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold A GREAT RED DRAGON, HAVING SEVEN HEADS AND TEN HORNS, and SEVEN CROWNS UPON HIS HEADS.*



In Revelation 12:3, **the Great Red Dragon** has *seven heads that are crowned*, and has *ten horns that are not crowned*.
