## #230 The Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1 – The December 15, 1791, Bill of Rights of the U.S. Constitution represents the fulfillment of the *Ten Horns* of the Revelation 13:1 Beast out of the Sea

The Daniel 7:8 'Little Horn' Kingdom of America has *Ten Horns*, because it is the same kingdom as the Revelation 13:1 Beast out of the *Sea* that has *Ten Horns*, as well as the same kingdom as the Revelation 17:08 Beast out of the *Pit* that has *Ten Horns*.

Key Understanding: The Bill of Rights represents the ten horns of Revelation 13:1. The Bill of Rights, or the first <u>Ten Amendments</u>, of the U.S. Constitution is/are the fulfillment of the Ten Horns with Ten Crowns on the Revelation 13:1 Beast out of the Sea. The Bill of Rights, representing the crowning of American democracy, was chosen by and ordained by God to represent the Crown Shift from Autocracy to Democracy.

Revelation 13:1 (KJV) And I stood upon the sand of the sea[shore], and saw <u>A</u> [Daniel 7:8 Little Horn]

BEAST RISE UP OUT OF THE

SEA, HAVING SEVEN HEADS

AND <u>TEN HORNS</u>, and <u>UPON HIS</u>

[Ten] <u>HORNS TEN CROWNS</u>, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.

Again, the Bill of Rights – the first *Ten Amendments* – of the U.S. Constitution <u>completed</u> and <u>crowned</u> the process of the establishment of the democratic representative government of the United States. The *Autocracy* of Kings was being replaced by the

representative *Democracy* of 'We the People.' **The Bill of Rights was (a) not only being** crowned, but was (b) the crowning event in establishing 'We the People' as kings over their government.
