#258 The Austrian Successor – Double Deaths, Double Heirs to Thrones, Double Wars of the Double Wars, Double Treaties, Double Ten Horns

Review (from the previous Unsealing). Austria's Charles VI died in 1740 (October 20). Prussia's Frederick William I had agreed to the Pragmatic Sanction much earlier, but he also died in 1740 (May 31), enabling his son, Frederick II (Frederick the Great), to begin his reign shortly before Charles VI's daughter, Maria Theresa, began her reign. Frederick II reneged on the agreement, beginning his invasion of Silesia on December 16, 1740, and securing the rich province for Prussia.

Now we expand upon Unsealings #249 and #255 to include even more *doubles*. The War of the Austrian Succession was a direct result of (a) the 1740 *double* deaths of the rulers of the Austrian and Prussian empires, which brought about (b) *two* new respective heirs to the thrones of Austria and Prussia in 1740.

Key Understanding: *Even more doubles*. The Lord designed that the Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7 be a part of Double Deaths and Double Heirs in Prussia and Austria in 1740, then Double Wars of Double Wars, and then Double Treaties, to ultimately emphasize the truth that the Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7 and the Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1 represent *doubles*.

(a) **Double Deaths in 1740** – Prussian King Frederick William I died on May 31, 1740. Austrian Holy Roman Emperor Charles VI died on October 20, 1740.




(b) Double Heirs in 1740 – Frederick II came to the throne of Prussia in 1740. Maria Theresa ascended the throne of Austria in 1740. The events of the double deaths and double ascensions to the thrones of Prussia and Austria would bring forth the War of the Austrian Succession.




Maria Theresa (*left*) ascended the throne of Austria in 1740. Frederick II (*right*) ascended the throne of Prussia in 1740.


- (c) **Double Silesian Wars** the First (1740-1742) and Second (1744-1745) Silesian Wars within the War of the Austrian Succession (1740-1748)
- (d) **Double Austrian-Prussian Wars** the War of the Austrian Succession (1740-1748) and its *continuation*, the Seven Years' War (1756-1763)



(e) **Double Wars of 1754-1763 and 1756-1763**– the French and Indian War (1754-1763) and the Seven Years' War (1756-1763)



(f) Double Treaties – the February 10, 1763, Treaty of Paris and the February 15, 1763, Treaty of Hubertusburg



(g) Double Ten Horns –

the Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7 (attached to the Double Wars above) / the 'Bill of Rights' Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1



Daniel 7:7 (KJV) After this I saw in the night visions, and <u>BEHOLD A FOURTH BEAST</u> [the Roman Empire, which came up from the sea], dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it was diverse from all the beasts that were before it; and <u>IT</u> <u>HAD TEN HORNS</u> [fulfilled in the French and Indian War (1754-1763) / Seven Years' War (1756-1763), which ended with the Treaty of Hubertusburg on February 15, 1763, 29 years less 2 months before the December 15, 1791, Bill of Rights].

Revelation 13:1 (KJV) And I stood upon the sand of the sea[shore], and saw <u>A</u> [Daniel 7:8 Little Horn 'Fourth Rome'] <u>BEAST RISE UP OUT OF THE SEA</u>, HAVING SEVEN HEADS AND TEN HORNS, and <u>UPON HIS</u> [Ten] <u>HORNS TEN CROWNS</u>, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy. [The Ten Horns with Ten Crowns are fulfilled through the Bill of Rights of December 15, 1791, 29 years less 2 months after the February 15, 1763, Treaty of Hubertusburg ended the Seven Years' War.]
