
## #274 The Cross of Jesus Christ vs. the Rights of Man – Jesus with Nicodemus vs. Col. John Nixon: Spiritual Births vs. Natural Births

In Unsealing #5, we contrasted <u>Col. John Nixon</u> vs. <u>Jesus with Nicodemus</u> through the subject of the *Natural* Birth vs. the *Spiritual* Birth. We are repeating the content of Unsealing #5 <u>Col. John</u> <u>Nixon</u> and the *Natural* Birth vs. Jesus and Nicodemus and the *Spiritual* Birth.

Key Understanding (of Unsealing #5): The natural birth vs. the spiritual birth. The central doctrine of the Declaration of Independence, first read publicly on July 8, 1776, by Col. John Nixon, is mankind's "natural birthright" to Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of Happiness, a supposed "right" given to one by God at one's natural birth. This is in direct contrast and emphasis to the doctrines of Jesus Christ surrounding the spiritual birth – being 'born again' – spoken to Nicodemus in John 3:3. [Remember, the root from which the name Nixon is derived is the same as the root of the name Nixon in the first place – so that the doctrine of the 'natural birthrights' first birth would be contrasted with the doctrine of the born again second birth.]

Nixon, in fulfillment of Daniel 7:8, "... A MOUTH SPEAKING GREAT THINGS ... "

Daniel 7:8 (KJV) I considered the [ten] horns, and, behold, there came up among them another LITTLE HORN, before whom there were THREE OF THE FIRST HORNS plucked up by the roots: and, behold, in this horn were eyes like the eyes of man, and <u>A MOUTH</u> <u>SPEAKING GREAT THINGS</u> [referring to the Declaration of Independence and its meaning and doctrines, first read publicly by a mouth on 7/8, in fulfillment of Daniel 7:8].
