#299 The Image of the Beast – "World Peace through Democracy" has been the combined hope of the Beast and the Image of the Beast


Key Understanding: "World Peace through Democracy" has been the combined hope of the Beast and the Image of the Beast, partly seen through the December 10-15 Human Rights Week coupling of the Beast's *Bill of Rights of December 15 (1791)* with the Image of the Beast's *Universal Declaration of Human Rights of December 10 (1948)*.

Without yet going through much of an explanation of either the League of Nations or the United Nations, we can see the "World Peace through Democracy" relationship between the United States and the United Nations through "human rights." One example is in the next paragraph.

Human Rights Week. In Unsealings #250–#251, we discussed the United Nations Universal Declaration of Human Rights of December 10, 1948. Because of that, December 10 is called International Human Rights Day. In the United States, Bill of Rights Day is December 15. Combining the two together, December 10-15 in the United States is called Human Rights Week.

The Beast's *Bill of Rights* was coupled with the Image of the Beast's *Universal Declaration of Human Rights*, illustrating the understanding that "World Peace through Democracy" has been the combined hope of the Beast and the Image of the Beast.

[Remember, we also discussed in Unsealing #251 the relevance of the 186 "double her double" years less 2 months from the February 10, 1763, Treaty of Paris to the December 10, 1948, Universal Declaration of Human Rights.]
