#303 The Image of the Beast – Wilson's Fourteenth Point: From a Partnership of Democratic Nations to the League of Nations

Up until this point as concerns the Image of the Beast, we have primarily been focusing on a 'Partnership of Democratic Nations,' which ultimately became the League of Nations. Now we are ready to discuss the League of Nations.

Key Understanding: From a Partnership of Democratic Nations to the League of Nations. The desire in the heart and mind of Woodrow Wilson for a Partnership of Democratic Nations in the image of America, the Beast, soon became the 'Image of the Beast' League of Nations.

The United States entered World War I on April 6, 1917. In a famous and defining speech given on January 8, 1918, in the midst of the war, Woodrow Wilson outlined his Fourteen Points to bring world peace. The creation of a League of Nations was the Fourteenth Point:

"A general association of nations must be formed under specific covenants for the purpose of affording mutual guarantees of political independence and territorial integrity to great and small states alike."

The card *below* expounds upon the key dates of the origin of the League of Nations. The League of Nations was birthed as part of the signing of the June 28, 1919, Treaty of Versailles, which officially ended World War I.

ORIGIN OF THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS

January 8th, 1918. Fourteen Points laid down by President Wilson as the basis of world peace. (*)

January 25th, 1919. League accepted in principle.

April 28th, 1919. Covenant adopted.

January 10th, 1920. League came into being; Secretariat established in London.



(*) THE FOURTEENTH POINT :

January 16th, 1920. First meeting of Council at Paris.

November 1st, 1920. League Headquarters moved from London to Geneva.

November 15th, 1920. First Meeting of Assembly at Geneva.
