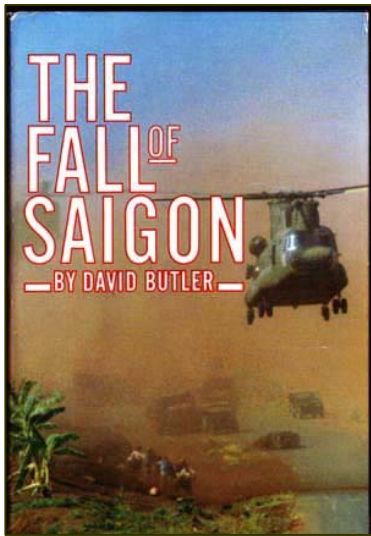
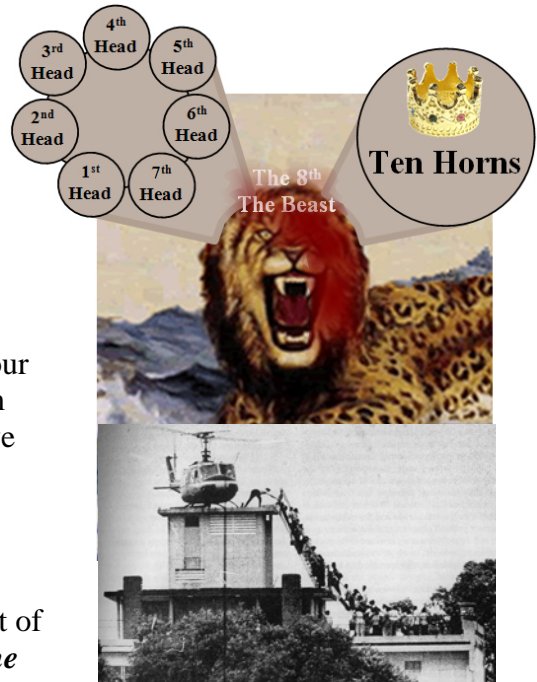


#354 The Deadly Wound of the Beast, Phase II – The Vietnam War: A Cold War Civil War that reflected the polarization of the Dragon’s 7th Head USSR and 8th Head U.S.

The Vietnam War. The two largest civil wars attached to the larger Cold War between the 7th and 8th Heads of the Dragon were the Korean War (1950-1953) and the Vietnam War (1957-1975). Many consider the Vietnam War a “proxy war,” because the major players of the U.S. and USSR were unwilling to fight one another directly because of the unacceptable cost of global nuclear war. In the Vietnam War, North Vietnam’s most powerful allies were Communist China and the USSR, while South Vietnam’s most powerful ally was the United States. Large amounts of war material came to North Vietnam from China and the Soviet Union, while both troops and supplies came from the United States in support of South Vietnam.



Key Understanding: *The Vietnam War head wound.* At first hearing, it may seem odd to link the Vietnam War with a head wound. However, the Vietnam War was entirely attached to the larger Cold War between the Dragon’s 7th Head USSR and 8th Head U.S. It was the 8th Head U.S. that was wounded through its loss of the Vietnam War.



At this time, we are going to use Revelation 13:12 as our key verse for the Beast’s deadly wound of the Vietnam War. Then, after we later progress to a certain point, we can better incorporate the proper understandings into Revelation 13:3.

Revelation 13:12 (KJV) And he [the Second Beast] exerciseth all the power of the first beast [the Beast out of the Sea in Revelation 13:1] before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship THE FIRST BEAST [the Beast out of the Sea in Revelation 13:1, the 8th Head of the Dragon], WHOSE DEADLY WOUND [of the Vietnam War] WAS HEALED.
