<u>#357 The Deadly Wound of the Beast, Phase II – September 2, 1945: The End of World</u> War II and the Beginning of Ho Chi Minh's Vietnam, part 2, Removing the Double Yoke of France and Japan

Key Understanding: There was a <u>direct</u> relationship between the *healing, or end*, of the Pearl Harbor *World War II* Head Wound and the *beginning* of the Vietnam War *Cold War* Head Wound. The official surrender of Japan to America on September 2, 1945, represented the *healing* of the Pearl Harbor (the *first*) deadly wound to the 8th Head of the Dragon. But the surrender of Japan on September 2, 1945, simultaneously birthed Ho Chi Minh's nation of Vietnam, a nation which would represent another (the *second*) deadly wound to America, the 8th Head of the Dragon.

When France was defeated by Nazi Germany in 1940, Ho crossed from China into Vietnam and founded the Viet Minh, the League for the Independence of Vietnam. But it was not until the end of World War II that Ho's opportunity to seize power came as a result of two events. The first was the Japanese decision in 1945 to attack and defeat the Vichy French forces in Vietnam. The second was the atomic bomb attack on Hiroshima and the sudden Japanese surrender. These two events in quick succession left a political vacuum in Vietnam – the French and Japanese were both left without power – and **Ho rushed to fill it by declaring Vietnamese independence on September 2, 1945**.
