

Thomas **Jefferson** wrote the Declaration of Independence when America revolted against Great Britain, and **Jefferson** Davis quoted from that same Declaration of Independence when the South seceded from the Union.

Thomas **Jefferson** and the Declaration of Independence represented the revolution against Lord North, the Prime Minister of Great Britain. This was in fulfillment of America lifting up its horn against the Lord in the north (Psalm 75:5-7). **Jefferson** Davis represented the Confederate South in its revolution against the North.
