<u>#385 The Deadly Wound of the Beast, Phase II – Red China and the Rising of the Red</u> <u>River, and the Drying Up of the Euphrates River</u>

We clearly see that the history leading up to the official Vietnam War between the United States/South Vietnam and Ho Chi Minh's North Vietnam is entwined with the rise of Red China. The Lord has made it clear that the "Six-Head River," or Red River, is symbolically and prophetically important.

For years, a prophetic theory has been that the rise of Mao's Red China was essentially the rise of who will fulfill the role of the "Kings of the East" seen in Revelation 16:12. The Kings of the East are associated with the drying up of the Euphrates River. [See also Revelation 9:13-16.]





Revelation 16:12 (KJV) And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon THE GREAT RIVER EUPHRATES; and THE WATER THEREOF WAS DRIED UP, that the way of <u>THE KINGS</u> <u>OF THE EAST</u> might be prepared.



Key Understanding: Thus, we see Red China tied to both (a) the idea of the *rising* <u>Red River</u>, which in part symbolizes the birth and rise in power of Red China itself, and (b) the *drying up* of the <u>Euphrates River</u>, *if* Red China represents the Kings of the East.

It actually seems logical that this would be a beginning of the process through the Unsealings of proving that Red China constitutes the Kings of the East and is connected to the drying up of the Euphrates River, since the Lord has shown that another river – the Red River – is symbolically attached to Red China and its birth and rise in power. In fact, the entire point of interpreting that Red China constitutes the Kings of the East of Revelation 16:12 is indeed totally associated with the political rise of Mao and Communism in China. In other words, the

fulfillment of the rise of the Kings of the East was essentially the rise of Mao's Communist regime that encompassed China.

[Note: Red China is not generally called <u>*Red</u> China* as much today, but simply *China*, since the country's turn toward a market economy and capitalism in the last three decades.]</u>

But <u>will</u> the Chinese fulfill the role as the Kings of the East of Revelation 16:12? We will not be answering that question immediately, but yes, this was the first step in explaining and addressing the question.
