The title of this Unsealing – <u>In God's eyes, "One Nation, Under God" represents "Imagine there's no Heaven"</u> – seems like a ludicrous statement because "One Nation, Under God" seems to have "heaven" written all over it. But one must look at the matter with the eyes of God, not with the eyes of the harlot church. "One Nation, Under God" has *earth* written all over it.

"One Nation, Under God" is a lie. It seems like an acceptable lie though, perhaps even happily

received by the Lord, for it seems to be exalting Him. However, "One Nation, Under God" is not exalting the Lord. Instead, the deceitful but well-hidden purpose of "One Nation, Under God" in the dark hearts of men is to exalt what is really "of men" as if it were "of God".

Remember, as concerns the Cold War contest between the 'Imagine there's no heaven' Red USSR and the 'One Nation, Under God' Scarlet Beast U.S., the lie in the hearts and minds of those of the Scarlet Beast/Scarlet Beast's Church has the 7<sup>th</sup> Head *Red* USSR in the role of the Great Red Dragon's 8<sup>th</sup> Head *Scarlet* Beast – including its defeat of the 7<sup>th</sup> Head, Third Reich Germany – and has the Great *Red* Dragon's 8<sup>th</sup> Head Scarlet Beast U.S. in the role of the Lord's millennial-type 'One Nation Under God' on earth. Thus,



the *Scarlet* Beast United States represents a counterfeit of the Lord's millennial government upon the earth. This is not acceptable to the Lord. In fact, it is all so unacceptable to the Lord that he actually views the 'One Nation Under God' United States similar to how the United States looks at the 'Imagine there's no heaven' USSR. In other words...

Key Understanding: The Lord views the Scarlet Beast United States as if it actually represents "Imagine there's no heaven."

Here is why. The Lord looks at the United States as a false Promised Land for many in the world, possessing a false light – essentially the Enlightenment light. Rather than having *heaven* in their hearts, it is the *earthly* kingdom of America and what it represents that is most often in the hearts of those in the harlot church, though it all comes in the name of God. America became the substitute for heaven – "heaven on earth" – and the Lord therefore constructed the theme of "Imagine there's no heaven." Similar to John Lennon's "Imagine", the "One Nation, Under God" doctrine even assumes that the Lord's return from heaven is *not* needed to bring peace to the earth, for there is the formula of "World Peace through Democracy." After all, <u>THE PEOPLE</u> <u>IS ONE</u>, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now NOTHING WILL BE <u>RESTRAINED</u> FROM THEM, which they have <u>IMAGINED</u> to do, Genesis 11:6 (KJV).
