#464 Thomas Paine and God Trying Men's Souls – The Hour of Temptation and the Church of Philadelphia, part 4, Trying Men's Souls with the offering of the kingdom birthed in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

Matthew 4:8-9 (KJV) Again, the devil [called THE TEMPTER in verse 3] taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, AND SHEWETH HIM ALL THE KINGDOMS OF THE WORLD, AND THE GLORY OF THEM;

9 And saith unto him, <u>ALL THESE THINGS WILL I GIVE THEE</u>, if thou wilt fall down and worship me.

Key Understanding:

Trying men's souls with the offering of the kingdom birthed in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. The Lord constructed the fulfillment of the Hour of Temptation – which shall come upon all the world, to TRY them that dwell upon the earth – in the letter to the Church in Philadelphia in Revelation 3:10, to be directly



attached to the offering by the Tempter of Thomas Paine's Philadelphia, Pennsylvania-birthed Age of Reason/Enlightenment kingdom – the United States of America. Thomas Paine's words of *These are the times that TRY men's souls*, published near the end of 1776, were his version of *trying men's souls* through the choice between governments ruled by kings vs. governments ruled by the people. Instead, Paine's words of *These are the times that TRY men's souls* were ordained by God to represent the fulfillment of the Hour of



Revelation 3:7, 10 (KJV) And to the angel of the <u>CHURCH IN PHILADELPHIA</u> write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;

10 Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, <u>I also will keep thee from THE HOUR</u>

<u>OF TEMPTATION</u>, which shall come upon all the world, <u>TO TRY THEM</u> that dwell upon the earth.
