## #471 The Unholy Concord – April 19, 1775: What Concord hath Christ with Belial?

The Lord ordained the start of America's Revolutionary War to occur in Massachusetts at Lexington and Concord on April 19, 1775. The Lord's reason for ordaining Concord to such a place in history can be designated by the theme of **The Unholy Concord**.

The start of the Revolutionary War represented the marriage of the Lord's (supposed) heavenly kingdom Church to an earthly State – the United States of America. The very phrase "One Nation Under God" reflects that unholy marriage of Church with State. As was unsealed recently in George Washington to George H. W. Bush, U.S. Presidents – in the eyes of God – hold the position of antichrist heads of the Church in the "One Nation Under God" *unholy concord* marriage of Christ with Belial, and light with darkness.

Key Understanding: *The unholy Concord*. The Lord sees the unholy marriage of the Church in America with the State of America as an *unholy concord* of believers, who are supposed to be the Light of the World, with those who are of the darkness of the



Enlightenment of the World. At Concord on April 19, 1775, began the Unholy Concord of (a) those who are supposed to be the heavenly kingdom Body of Christ aligning themselves with (b) the earthly Enlightenment Body of Americans, through the spirit and doctrine of "One Nation Under God." It was in fulfillment of 2 Corinthians 6:15.

2 Corinthians 6:14-18 (KJV) <u>BE YE NOT UNEQUALLY</u> <u>YOKED TOGETHER WITH UNBELIEVERS</u>: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?


15 <u>AND WHAT CONCORD HATH CHRIST WITH</u> <u>BELIAL</u>? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel?

16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I

will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. 17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,

18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.

[Note: *Belial* in the Old Testament is a Hebrew word used well over a dozen times to essentially mean *worthlessness* or *wickedness*. It is first found in Deuteronomy 13:13, so it is not by happenstance that the Lord designed the use of *Belial* in association with the April 19, 1775, *Concord* beginning of the rebellion of the original 13 states. In 2 Corinthians 6:15, the word seems to be used more as a name for Satan, as a personification of evil.]
