## #529 The Rise of Michael the Archangel – From Boris and Mikhail to Mikhail and Boris

(1) The *first Time of Troubles* featured **Boris** and **Mikhail**.



**Boris** Godunov (*pictured left*) was Tsar of Russia (1598-1605) and was associated with the *beginning* of the <u>first</u> Time of Troubles. <u>Mikhail</u> Feodorovich Romanov (*pictured right*) was Tsar of Russia (1613-1645) and ended the <u>first</u> Time of Troubles.



## (2) The second Time of Troubles involved Mikhail.

Pseudo-Tsar <u>Mikhail</u> Alexandrovich Romanov was a part of the story – especially a part of the *prophetic* story – of the <u>second</u> Time of Troubles during the time period of the Russian Revolutions (1917) and the Russian Civil War (1918-1920).

## (3) The *third Time of Troubles* featured Mikhail and Boris.

While Boris preceded Mikhail in the <u>first Time of</u> Troubles, <u>Mikhail</u> Gorbachev (right in the picture) would precede <u>Boris</u> Yeltsin (left in the picture) in the <u>third</u> Time of Troubles. Mikhail Gorbachev led the Soviet Union (1985-1991), and Boris Yeltsin was President of Russia (1991-1999).





Key Understanding: *Mikhail* and Boris. Just as the <u>first</u> Time of Troubles featured a <u>Boris</u> and a <u>Mikhail</u>, the "time of the end" fall of the Soviet Union also featured a <u>Mikhail</u> and a <u>Boris</u>, leading many in Russia to easily label the time period of great instability after the 1991 fall of the Soviet Union as the <u>third</u> Time of Troubles in Russia's history.



Daniel 12:1 (KJV) And at that time <u>SHALL MICHAEL</u> [the Archangel] <u>STAND UP</u>, the great prince which standeth for <u>THE CHILDREN OF THY PEOPLE</u>: and <u>there shall be</u> <u>A TIME OF TROUBLE</u>, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book.
