
<u>#560 The Reagan/Regan-Bush Habitation of Devils – Matthew 12:25-26: Every Kingdom</u> <u>Divided Against Itself</u>

Key Understanding: *The Exorcist and Matthew 12:26*. The Lord ordained the movie *The Exorcist* to open on 12/26 (1973) to point to Matthew 12:26. The theme of Matthew 12:25-26 is that of a *Kingdom Divided* against itself. The overriding issue is one of 'God casting out Satan' as opposed to 'Satan casting out Satan.' It will soon match up with our recent overall discussions and understandings concerning Daniel 12:1 and Michael the Archangel, for they too have been about the Lord's deliverance as opposed to deliverances via the emissaries of Satan.

Matthew 12:22-30 (KJV) Then was brought unto him one possessed with a devil, blind, and dumb: and he healed him, insomuch that the blind and dumb both spake and saw. 23 And all the people were amazed, and said, Is not this the son of David? 24 But when the Pharisees heard it, they said, This fellow doth not cast out devils, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils. 25 And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them. **EVERY KINGDOM DIVIDED** AGAINST ITSELF is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand: 26 And IF SATAN CAST OUT SATAN, HE IS DIVIDED

AGAINST HIMSELF; how shall then his kingdom stand? 27 And if I by Beelzebub cast out

28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you. 29 Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first bind the strong man? and then he will spoil his house.

30 He that is not with me is against me; and he that gathereth not with me scattereth abroad.
