## #586 Ornan's Threshingfloor – Judgment and Threshingfloors: Gone with the Wind, like the Chaff of the Summer Threshingfloors

During our studies of Nebuchadnezzar's Image, in Unsealing #133 Crushing the Feet of Clay — The Daniel 2:34-35 Stone (that becomes a Great Mountain) is the Rod of Iron Ruler of Rev. 19:15, it was discussed that the Stone that becomes a Great Mountain and that crushes the Feet of Iron and Clay of Nebuchadnezzar's Image in Daniel 2:34, is the same as the Rod of Iron Ruler (and his kingdom) of Revelation 19:15.

**Like the chaff of the summer threshingfloors.** As you review the verses of Daniel 2:34-35 and Revelation 19:15 (*below*), recall that the final world power of Nebuchadnezzar's Image represents the culmination of man's rule upon the earth, and the destruction of it results in the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold being broken to pieces together. We are now emphasizing that they become *like the chaff of the summer threshingfloors that the wind carries away*.

Daniel 2:34-35 (KJV) Thou sawest till that <u>A STONE WAS CUT OUT WITHOUT</u> [human] <u>HANDS, WHICH SMOTE THE IMAGE UPON HIS FEET THAT WERE OF IRON AND CLAY, AND BRAKE THEM TO PIECES.</u>

35 THEN WAS THE IRON, THE CLAY, THE BRASS, THE SILVER, AND THE GOLD, BROKEN TO PIECES TOGETHER, and became LIKE THE CHAFF OF THE SUMMER THRESHINGFLOORS; AND THE WIND CARRIED THEM AWAY, that no place was found for them: and THE STONE THAT SMOTE THE IMAGE BECAME A GREAT MOUNTAIN, AND FILLED THE WHOLE EARTH.



**Revelation 19:14-15 (KJV)** And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

15 AND OUT OF HIS MOUTH GOETH A SHARP SWORD, THAT WITH IT HE SHOULD SMITE THE NATIONS: and <u>HE</u> [Jesus Christ] <u>SHALL RULE THEM WITH A ROD OF IRON</u>: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Judgment is connected with threshingfloors in scripture.

Key Understanding: *Judgment and threshingfloors*. The Lord's ceasing of his sword-bearing <u>judgment</u> upon David and Israel was connected with Ornan's <u>threshingfloor</u> (1 Chronicles 21), while the Lord's sword-bearing <u>judgment</u> (Revelation 19:14-15) upon the Feet of Clay of Nebuchadnezzar's Image (Daniel 2:34-35) – symbolizing the end of man's sword-bearing rule over the kingdoms of the earth – carries them away like the chaff of the summer <u>threshingfloors</u>.

Again, judgment is connected with threshingfloors in scripture.

Matthew 3:12 (NIV) His winnowing fork is in his hand, and <u>HE WILL CLEAR HIS THRESHING</u>
<u>FLOOR, GATHERING HIS WHEAT INTO THE</u>
<u>BARN AND BURNING UP THE CHAFF WITH</u>
<u>UNQUENCHABLE FIRE."</u>



Ornan's threshingfloor represents the building of the House of God, as defined by the separation of the <u>Wheat</u> from the <u>Chaff</u> through the critical aspect of the <u>Cross</u> vs. the <u>Sword</u>.
