

**#591 City on a Hill vs. Habitation of Devils – The Exorcists from Boston, England, and Boston, Massachusetts**

The legend is that St. Botolph chose demon-infested land for his monastery, around which grew the town of Boston, (county of) Lincolnshire, England. St. Botolph played the role of *The Exorcist*, making land haunted by demons into holy ground.



**Key Understanding:** *The roots of the U.S. as the exorcist. The larger spiritual/prophetic picture is that St. Botolph’s role as The Exorcist who founded the monastery at what became Boston, (county of) Lincolnshire, England, would extend to (a) the people that migrated from Boston, (county of) Lincolnshire, England, in the 1630’s to help create Boston, (state of) Massachusetts, U.S., as The City on a Hill, and then extend to (b) that same Boston, Massachusetts, in 1775 as The Cradle of Liberty.*

In short, Boston as *The City on a Hill* in 1630 (representing *Christianity*) would become Boston as *The Cradle of Liberty* in 1775 (representing *Democracy*), birthing a *Christian Democracy* that would play the role of God’s Redeemer Nation and *The Exorcist* of evil out of the world. Of course, *The Exorcist* nation has actually been *The ‘Blair House’ Exorcist* nation – Babylon the Great – itself the “*habitation of devils.*” It all began in the so-called demon-inhabited land that became Boston, (county of) Lincolnshire, England.
