
#594 City on a Hill vs. Habitation of Devils – (a) Ronald Reagan (from the Cold War) and (b) Boston, Massachusetts, (from the Revolutionary War) each reflect (i) A City on a Hill and (ii) The Exorcist "habitation of devils"

Ronald Reagan


In Ronald Reagan's farewell address to the nation on January 11, 1989, his description of America as a City on a Hill was referring back to John Winthrop's speech about creating the Massachusetts Bay Colony and Boston, Massachusetts, as a City Upon a Hill. In his address, Reagan called Winthrop "an early Pilgrim, an early freedom man," easily bridging from the Puritan objective of religious freedom in 1630's Boston as part of the City Upon a Hill to Boston's Revolutionary War identity as The Cradle of Liberty.





The Lord ordained that through the person of Ronald Reagan there exists the contrast of America as a Matthew 5:14 *City on a Hill* (which was Reagan's viewpoint, and false) vs. America as a Revelation 18:2 'Regan' "habitation of devils" (which is the Lord's viewpoint, and true), though it is playing the role of *The Exorcist* of evil.

Key Understanding: Both (a) Ronald Reagan and (b) Boston, Massachusetts, reflect the themes of (i) A City on a Hill



and (ii) *The Exorcist* "habitation of devils." To understand it further, Boston, Massachusetts, represented America as *The Exorcist* of the evil of Kings (and Great Britain) in the Revolutionary War at the time of the beginning of America's history, while Ronald Reagan represented the more mature America as *The Exorcist* of the evil of Communism (and the Soviet Union) at the "time of the end."

The key verse for (i) The City Upon a Hill is Matthew 5:14.

Matthew 5:14 (KJV) <u>YE ARE THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD</u>. <u>A CITY THAT IS SET ON AN HILL</u> cannot be hid.

The key verse for (ii) *The Exorcist* of the "habitation of devils" is Revelation 18:2.

Revelation 18:2 (KJV) And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, <u>BABYLON THE</u> <u>GREAT IS FALLEN</u>, IS FALLEN, AND <u>IS BECOME THE HABITATION OF DEVILS</u>, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.
