#601 Salem Rebellion, Salem Witchcraft – The Voice of the People and the Habitation of Devils, part 3, The English Bill of Rights of 1689 as The Exorcist

The English Bill of Rights of 1689 was discussed in Unsealings #268–#269 under the title of The England-Netherlands Pit – The English-Netherlands Bill of Rights of 1689, parts 1 and 2. William III of the House of Orange of the Netherlands became King of England, but only after promising to obey the Declaration of Rights, later known as the English Bill of Rights of 1689.

The English Bill of Rights was an antecedent of the American Bill of Rights.

Key Understanding: The English Bill of Rights of 1689 as The Exorcist. If the American Bill of Rights has played the role as The Exorcist, yet is the habitation of devils, then so too would the English Bill of Rights play the role as The Exorcist, yet be a habitation of devils. In fact, appropriate to our main point, Protestants William III and Mary II were invited by Protestants to land in England with Dutch forces to essentially exorcise the evil of Roman Catholic King James II from the throne.

The American Revolution

Like the American Bill of Rights, the English Bill of Rights represented the voice/will of the people. Just as the <u>American</u> Bill of Rights is tied spiritually/prophetically to the theme of *The Exorcist* (though being a habitation of devils), the <u>English</u> Bill of Rights was also tied to the theme of the exorcism of evil not only in England (referring to King James II) . . . but across the sea in America at Salem, as we are about to study.

In short, the key to understanding the spiritual/prophetic significance of the Salem Witchcraft Trials is to understand the event's spiritual/prophetic connection by the hand of God to the Glorious Revolution that brought William III of Orange to the throne.

1 Samuel 15:23 (KJV) <u>FOR REBELLION IS AS THE SIN OF WITCHCRAFT</u>, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king [speaking of Saul].
