
#608 Salem Rebellion, Salem Witchcraft – The Boston-Salem Rebellion of the Mathers in conjunction with the 1688 Glorious Revolution, part 4, Doubles: The 1688-1689 (English Bill of Rights) Boston Rebellion against the Dominion of New England and the 1775-1776 (U.S. Bill of Rights) Boston Rebellion against England


Key Understanding: *Double Boston rebellions*. Now we can see the clear doubles associated with what was happening with the Mathers in Boston and New England in 1688-1689 and what would happen in Boston and New England in 1775-1776. Moreover, the Boston rebellion against England's Dominion of New England in 1688-1689 became directly associated with the Glorious Revolution and <u>English Bill of Rights</u> of 1688-1689, while the Boston rebellion against England in 1775-1776, referring to the 1775 start of the Revolutionary War in Boston, Lexington, and Concord, and the 1776 Declaration of Independence, would eventually spawn the <u>U.S. Bill of Rights</u> of 1791. It is outlined *below*.

Double 'Boston' Revolutions against England:

(1) The Mathers' Boston Rebellion of 1688-1689:

- (a) The Mathers' Boston Rebellion of 1688-1689 was against
- (b) England's Dominion of New England and King James II, and succeeded because of the
- (c) 1688 Glorious Revolution, which birthed the
- (d) 1689 English Bill of Rights.





(2) The Boston Rebellion of 1775-1776:

- (a) The Boston Rebellion of 1775-1776 was against
- (b) England and King George III, and represented the
- (c) Revolutionary War, which eventually birthed the
- (d) 1791 U.S. Bill of Rights.

Note that we now see clear doubles of (i) the Glorious Revolution conflict between William III, Prince of Orange, and King James II, and (ii) the American Revolutionary War between the colonists and King George III. Also, the former birthed the English Bill of Rights of 1689, and the latter birthed the U.S. Bill of Rights of 1791.

Furthermore, the oddity occurred that **the colonies were** *forcibly* **united** *by England for England* in the Dominion of New England, and this is what the colonists rebelled against. Later, in the

Revolutionary War, **the colonies** *voluntarily* **united** *by themselves for themselves*, *against England*.
