Since we have mentioned that Boston Stump was eminent in establishing the roots of Babylon the Great, let's introduce a key passage for this series, Daniel 4:13-15. It is about the Lord deposing Nebuchadnezzar from his rule of Babylon, but leaving the stump and roots of Nebuchadnezzar's kingship over Babylon in the earth.

***Daniel 4:13-15 (KJV)** I saw in the visions of my head upon my bed, and, behold, a watcher and an holy one came down from heaven; 14 He cried aloud, and said thus, Hew down the tree, and cut off his branches, shake off his leaves, and scatter his fruit: let the beasts get away from under it, and the fowls from his branches:*

*15 Nevertheless **LEAVE THE STUMP OF HIS ROOTS IN THE EARTH**, even with a band of iron and brass, in the tender grass of the field; and let it be wet with the dew of heaven, and let his portion be with the beasts in the grass of the earth:*
