## #640 The Cotton Saints vs. the Linen Saints – The 'Clothed in Cotton' Saints vs. the 'Clothed in Linen' Saints

Now let's transition to <u>The Cotton Saints vs. the Linen Saints</u> from <u>The Woman is that Great City Babylon</u>.



Key Understanding #1: Cotton replacing linen. Cotton is used to make clothing and linen is used to make clothing. In scripture, the true saints of God are clothed in fine

white linen. The Lord ordained the theme of Cotton Saints to describe those who are the counterfeit of, or the replacement for, the Lord's Linen Saints.



## The 'Clothed in Linen' Saints

Revelation 19:11-15 (KJV) And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. 12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God. 14 And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, <u>CLOTHED IN</u> FINE LINEN, WHITE AND CLEAN.

15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Key Understanding #2: The 'clothed in cotton' sword-bearing saints. While the 'Clothed in Linen' Saints will rule and reign with Jesus Christ after his return, the sword-bearing 'Clothed in Cotton' Saints attempt to rule and reign for Jesus Christ over the governments of the world before the Lord's return, in a millennial type of spirit.
