#663 The Churchill Saints of Daniel 7:21 – Making War with the Saints

Now let's transition from <u>Constantine the Great and Woodrow Wilson</u> to <u>The Churchill Saints</u> <u>of Daniel 7:21</u> in order to better understand the true meaning of Daniel 7:21. We will eventually return to <u>Constantine the Great and Woodrow Wilson</u>.

Daniel 7:21 (KJV) I beheld, and <u>THE SAME HORN</u> [the Daniel 7:8 Little Horn Nation of America] <u>MADE WAR</u> <u>WITH THE SAINTS</u>, and prevailed against them;

Key Understanding: It is seen in Daniel 7:21 that the Little Horn, which is America, makes war with the saints, and prevails against them.




Daniel 7:19-28 are verses in the latter part of the passage of Daniel 7 about Little Horn America arising out of the Ten Horns of the Roman Empire. [Of course, Little Horn America itself also has Ten Horns, seen in Revelation 13:1 as the Beast that arises out of the sea with Ten Horns. This all was comprehensively explained in Unsealings #205-#216, The Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7, and Unsealings #217-#237, The Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1.]

Daniel 7:19-28 (KJV) Then I would know the truth of the fourth beast [the Roman Empire], which was diverse from all the others, exceeding dreadful, whose teeth were of iron, and his nails of brass; which devoured, brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with his feet; 20 And of the ten horns that were in his head [reflected through the Seven Years' War (1756-1763), a war among Ten European Powers, including England, France, and Spain], and of the other which came up [Little Horn America, as a result of the Seven Years' War], and before

whom three fell [England, France, and Spain, uprooted by Mexico, which was then uprooted by the United States in the 1846-1848 Mexican War]; even of that horn that had eyes [like the eyes of blind men, see Unsealings #319—#329], and a mouth that spake very great things [partially reflected through the first public reading of the Declaration of Independence in Philadelphia, Pa., by Col. John Nixon on July 8, 1776, to fulfill Daniel 7:8], whose look was more stout than his fellows.

21 I beheld, and <u>THE SAME HORN</u> [the Daniel 7:8 Little Horn Nation of America] <u>MADE WAR WITH THE SAINTS</u>, and prevailed against them;

22 Until the Ancient of days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the most High; and the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom.

- 23 Thus he said, The fourth beast [the Roman Empire] shall be the fourth kingdom upon earth, which shall be diverse from all kingdoms, and shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces.
- 24 And the ten horns out of this kingdom are ten kings that shall arise [reflected through the Seven Years' War (1756-1763), a war among Ten European Powers, including England, France, and Spain]: and another [Little Horn America] shall rise after them [on July 4, 1776]; and he shall be diverse from the first, and he shall subdue three kings [England, France, and Spain, uprooted by Mexico, which was then uprooted by the United States in the 1846-1848 Mexican War].
- 25 And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times [the changing of times from the rule of the Ten Kings to the rule of the Bill of Rights as the Ten Kings, verified by the time change from the Julian calendar to the Gregorian calendar; reference Unsealings #239—#244] and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.
- 26 But the judgment shall sit, and they shall take away his dominion, to consume and to destroy it unto the end.
- 27 And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him.
- 28 Hitherto is the end of the matter. As for me Daniel, my cogitations much troubled me, and my countenance changed in me: but I kept the matter in my heart.
