## #670 The Churchill Saints of Daniel 7:21 – May 10, 1940 = Daniel 7:21: Churchill making war with the saints, and prevailing against them

Winston Churchill's call-to-arms in his May 13, 1940, speech to the House of Commons was ordained to use basically the identical phraseology – <u>wage war</u> – as is rendered in Daniel 7:21 (NIV) – <u>waging war</u>. Churchill and Britain viewed themselves as <u>waging</u> war... with the help of God.

We covered in the series Ornan's Threshingfloor (Unsealings #571–#587) the subject that those who use the sword, die by the sword (Unsealing #576). The key passage was Matthew 26:51-53.

Matthew 26:51-53 (KJV) And, behold, ONE OF THEM [Peter] WHICH WERE WITH JESUS STRETCHED OUT HIS HAND, AND <u>DREW HIS SWORD</u>, and struck a servant of the high priest's, and smote off his ear.

52 Then said Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place: FOR ALL THEY THAT TAKE THE SWORD SHALL PERISH WITH THE SWORD.



53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?

Very Important Point: Spiritually prevailing against the saints. Similar to the proper understanding that the use of the sword depicted and predicted what was spiritually lacking in Peter, Winston Churchill would make war with the Church-ill saints, prevailing against them spiritually.

Daniel 7:21 (KJV) I beheld, and THE SAME HORN [the Daniel 7:8 Little Horn Nation of America] MADE WAR WITH THE [Church-ill] SAINTS, and prevailed against them;

Key Understanding: May 10, 1940, was a fulfillment of Daniel 7:21. With the 2 months + 11 days date change, May 10 = 5:10 =



7:21. The Lord intends for us to see that <u>the weighty, simultaneous May 10, 1940, historical events</u> of (a) Churchill becoming the wartime Prime Minister of Great Britain and (b)

Hitler's invasion of Western Europe <u>fulfill Daniel 7:21</u>, specifically through Churchill's first speech to the House of Commons as Prime Minister on May 13, 1940, that contained the call-to-arms of:

You ask, what is our policy? I say *it is to wage war*, by land, sea, and air. War with all our might and *with all the strength God has given us*, and *to wage war* against a monstrous tyranny never surpassed in the dark and lamentable catalogue of human crime. That is our policy.
