#744 Constantine the Great and Woodrow Wilson, II – Repeat of Unsealing #661: Representing the beginning and the end of the Christian Autocratic Eastern Roman **Empire, respectively**

To lay the proper foundation for the upcoming Unsealings, it will help to review the content of Unsealing #661. Here it is. Read it closely.

#661 Constantine the Great and Woodrow Wilson – Representing the beginning and the end of the Christian Autocratic Eastern Roman Empire, respectively

We are now progressing from The Cotton Saints vs. the Linen Saints to **Constantine the Great** and Woodrow Wilson.

Constantine the Great and Woodrow Wilson.

There is a relationship *historically* and prophetically between Constantine and Woodrow Wilson. In fact, their prophetic relationship is directly related to their *historical* relationship.

Key Understanding #1: The historical and prophetic relationship between Constantine the Great and Woodrow Wilson. This Unsealing is about the *historical* relationship as concerns the Eastern Roman Empire(s). Quite simply, what began with Constantine the Great



(representing the Second Rome) ended with Tsar Nicholas II (representing the Third Rome) and Woodrow Wilson (representing the Fourth Rome).

The Second Rome. Constantine the Great represents the beginning of a Christian Autocratic Eastern Roman **Empire.** On October 28, 312 A.D., Constantine the Great (275 A.D - 337 A.D.) won the struggle for control over the Roman Empire at the Battle of Milvian Bridge against Maxentius, claiming he had received a vision from God that he was to fight under the sign of the cross. [Reference Unsealing #42 and #42–Doc 1.] Another story says that Constantine ordered the Greek letters of *chi* and *rho*, the first two letters of Christ's name, to be marked on his soldiers' shields. This was the beginning of full-blown sword-bearing Christianity in the name of spreading the gospel. Constantine shifted the power center and capital of the Roman Empire from Rome to Constantinople, establishing it as the "Second Rome". He laid the foundations of the Eastern Roman (Greek Orthodox) Byzantine Empire, which would last for

1000 years. Constantine was involved with Christianity to such an extent that in 325 A.D. he presided over the first great ecumenical council of the Christian Church at Nicaea, in what is now northwestern Turkey. The council drew up the Nicene Creed. Obviously, with Constantine the Great presiding, the true understanding of the Cross vs. the Sword was missing. In the next Unsealing, we will begin to formulate the underpinnings for understanding Constantine's role as a major part of the fulfillment of Revelation 6:2.

Revelation 6:2 (KJV) And I saw, and behold <u>A WHITE HORSE</u>: and <u>HE THAT SAT ON</u> <u>HIM HAD A BOW</u>; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.

The Third Rome. After the fall of the Eastern Roman (Greek Orthodox) Byzantine Empire in 1453 A.D. to the Ottoman Turks, Moscow and the Eastern Orthodox Russian Empire claimed the mantle of the Third Rome.

The Fourth Rome. Woodrow Wilson represents *the end* of the Christian Autocratic Eastern Roman Empire. The fall of Tsar Nicholas II that signaled the end of the Russian Empire was immediately followed by Woodrow Wilson and America unknowingly assuming the mantle of a Christian Democracy Fourth Rome.

Key Understanding #2: From the second Rome to the fourth Rome. What Constantine the Great started (the Second Rome) ended with the demise of the Eastern Orthodox Russian Empire (the Third Rome), immediately followed by Woodrow Wilson-led America (the Fourth Rome) assuming Russia's place with the Allies in World War I.

Revelation 19:11-15 (KJV) And I saw heaven opened, and behold <u>A WHITE HORSE</u>; and <u>HE THAT SAT UPON HIM</u> was called Faithful and True, and <u>IN RIGHTEOUSNESS HE</u> <u>DOTH JUDGE AND MAKE WAR</u>. [Woodrow Wilson judged and made war in World War I, leading the counterfeit 1914 White Linen-Cotton Saints.]

12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.

14 And <u>THE ARMIES WHICH WERE IN HEAVEN FOLLOWED HIM UPON WHITE</u> HORSES, CLOTHED IN FINE LINEN, WHITE AND CLEAN.

15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.
