



Revelation 19:11 (KJV) And I saw heaven opened, and behold <u>A WHITE HORSE</u>; and <u>HE THAT SAT UPON HIM</u> was called Faithful and True, and <u>IN</u>
RIGHTEOUSNESS HE DOTH JUDGE
AND MAKE WAR. [Woodrow Wilson judged and made war in World War I, leading the counterfeit 1914 White Linen-Cotton
Saints, reference Unsealings #657—#659.]





Key Understanding: Constantine the Great and Woodrow Wilson each have an interrelated part in the fulfillment of the Revelation 6:2 Antichrist White Horse Rider. There are reasons for that, the understandings of which we will develop.

<u>HORSE</u>: and <u>HE</u> [Constantine the Great] <u>THAT SAT ON</u>

<u>HIM HAD A BOW</u>; and a crown was given unto him: and

HE WENT FORTH CONQUERING, AND TO CONQUER.

Woodrow Wilson

also has an enormous part in the fulfillment of Revelation 6:2:

Revelation 6:2 (KJV) And I saw, and behold <u>A WHITE HORSE</u>: and <u>HE</u> [Woodrow Wilson – we will directly call his horse Man o' War] <u>THAT SAT ON HIM HAD A BOW</u>; and a crown was given unto him: and <u>HE WENT FORTH CONQUERING</u>,

AND TO CONQUER.

Let's begin to understand more about the extensive roles of both Constantine the Great and Woodrow Wilson in Revelation 6:2.
