#747 Constantine the Great and Woodrow Wilson, II – The Opening of the Seals, part 1, Revelation Chapter 5: Who is worthy to loose the Seals?



The opening of the Seven Seals by the Lamb of God begins in Revelation 6:1-2. In other words, the opening of the First Seal is seen in Revelation 6:1-2.

Revelation 6:1 (KJV) And I saw when **THE**

<u>LAMB OPENED ONE OF THE SEALS</u>, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.

Revelation 6:2 (KJV) And I saw, and behold <u>A WHITE HORSE</u>: and <u>HE THAT SAT ON HIM</u> <u>HAD A BOW</u>; and a crown was given unto him: and <u>HE WENT FORTH CONQUERING</u>, AND TO CONQUER.

However, in this Unsealing and the next, let's read all of Revelation chapter 5 (a total of 14 verses), which leads into the opening of the First Seal in Revelation 6:1-2.

Revelation 5:1-5 (KJV) And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne <u>A BOOK</u> written within and on the backside, <u>SEALED WITH SEVEN SEALS</u>.

2 And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, <u>WHO IS WORTHY TO OPEN THE</u> <u>BOOK, AND TO LOOSE THE SEALS THEREOF?</u>

3 And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.

4 And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.

5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold,

THE LION OF THE TRIBE

OF JUDA, THE ROOT OF

DAVID, HATH PREVAILED

TO OPEN THE BOOK, AND

TO LOOSE THE SEVEN

SEALS THEREOF.

Key Understanding: Jesus Christ, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, was worthy to open the Seven Seals. Why was he worthy to loose the Seals?
