## #749 Constantine the Great and Woodrow Wilson, II – The Lamb, who represents the Cross, opens the First Seal, which is all about the Christian Sword

Key Understanding: *The cross vs. the sword*. The Lord wants us to see <u>the great contrast</u> between the picture in Revelation chapter 5 of the Lamb who is worthy to open the Seven Seals because he was slain on the *Cross*, and the picture in Revelation chapter 6 of his opening of the First Seal to reveal a *counterfeit* Christianity that is waging war with the *Sword*.

The Lamb, who represents the Cross . . .



Revelation 5:9-10 (KJV) And they sung a new song, saying, <u>THOU</u> [the Lamb] <u>ART WORTHY TO TAKE THE BOOK, AND TO OPEN THE SEALS THEREOF: FOR THOU WAST SLAIN</u>, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation:

10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: <u>AND WE SHALL</u> REIGN ON THE EARTH.

## ... opens the First Seal, which is all about the Christian Sword.



Revelation 6:1 (KJV) And I saw when <u>THE LAMB OPENED</u> <u>ONE OF THE SEALS</u> [the First Seal], and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.

Revelation 6:2 (KJV) And I saw, and behold <u>A WHITE HORSE</u>: and <u>HE</u> [Constantine the Great] <u>THAT SAT ON HIM HAD A</u> <u>BOW</u>; and a crown was given unto him: and <u>HE WENT FORTH</u> <u>CONQUERING</u>, <u>AND TO CONQUER</u>.

**Revelation 6:2 is all about the Christian** *Sword.* We recently covered in Unsealing #745 that because Revelation 6:2 is to be seen as a *counterfeit* of Revelation 19:11-14, it is reasonable to assume that the Revelation 6:2 White Horse Rider Antichrist goes forth conquering *with the* <u>Saints, just as the Revelation 19:11 White Horse Rider Jesus Christ goes forth conquering *with the Saints* in Revelation 19:14. [A counterfeit of Revelation 19:11-14 is Woodrow Wilson.]</u>

Revelation 19:11 (KJV) And I saw heaven opened, and behold <u>A WHITE HORSE</u>; and <u>HE THAT SAT UPON HIM</u> was called Faithful and True, and <u>IN RIGHTEOUSNESS HE</u>

**DOTH JUDGE AND MAKE WAR.** [Woodrow Wilson judged and made war in World War I, leading the counterfeit 1914 White Linen-Cotton Saints.]

What we are going to be concentrating on immediately, however, is Constantine the Great and his role in the fulfillment of Revelation 6:2.
