<u>#750 Constantine the Great and Woodrow Wilson, II – Constantine the Great: The first</u> <u>'Christian' Antichrist White Horse Rider figure in the fulfillment of Revelation 6:2</u>

Revelation 6:1 (KJV) And I saw when <u>THE LAMB OPENED ONE OF THE SEALS</u> [the First Seal], and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.

Revelation 6:2 (KJV) And I saw, and behold <u>A WHITE HORSE</u>: and <u>HE</u> [Constantine the Great] <u>THAT SAT ON HIM HAD A BOW</u>; and a crown was given unto him: and <u>HE WENT</u> <u>FORTH CONQUERING, AND TO CONQUER</u>.

Two Unsealings from now we will begin to get to the specifics that verify and clarify Constantine the Great fulfilling the White Horse Rider Antichrist of Revelation 6:2. However, in this Unsealing we are explaining in more general terms why Constantine the Great is a major figure in the fulfillment of the passage.

Key Understanding: *The Revelation 6:2 'Christian' white horse rider*. Because the White Horse Rider Jesus Christ represents Christianity in Revelation 19:11-14, the *sword*-bearing White Horse Rider of Revelation 6:2, although an antichrist figure in the eyes of God, is riding a White Horse because he is deemed to represent Christianity in the eyes of the world and of the deceived Church-ill.

Constantine the Great – fully representing Christianity – is history's first significant White Horse Rider Antichrist figure of Revelation 6:2.

Constantine and Christianity were entirely linked together:

- Constantine conquered under the sign of the cross Constantine famously conquered under the sign of the cross at the Battle of Milvian Bridge on October 28, 312.
- Constantine was the first emperor to legalize Christianity – Constantine, along with his coemperor Licinius, was the first to grant Christianity the status of a legalized religion, through the 313 Edict of Milan.
- Constantine summoned the First Council of Nicaea – Constantine summoned the first ecumenical conference of bishops of the Christian Church at Nicaea (in present-day Turkey) in 325, which resulted in the Nicene Creed.
