

## #799 The Black Horse Rider – December 10, 1991: Black Horse Day, part 8, The Day of Judgment of the Red Horse Rider by the Black Horse Rider

**Key Understanding:** *December 8-10, 1991, was the judgment of the red horse rider by the black horse rider. The December 8-10, 1991, demise – the “time of the end” – of the Soviet Union (fulfilling Daniel 12:8-10) represented the judgment of the Red Horse Rider Soviet Union by the Black Horse Rider United States. December 10, 1991, was Black Horse Day. That is why U.S. President George H. W. Bush signed the ‘Nighthorse’ bill on that day, changing the name of the Custer Battlefield National Monument to the Battle of Little Bighorn National Monument. Black Horse fought – and won – at the Battle of Little Bighorn. [We will soon explain why it was the ‘red men’ who won that battle.]*

The victory by the United States as the Black Horse Rider represented a victorious ‘ending’ – because of the defeat of the Red Horse Rider – for both (i) the Constantinian *longer* period of time of the conquering Antichrist White Horse Rider, and (ii) the Wilsonian *shorter* period of time of the conquering Antichrist White Horse Rider.



*Revelation 6:3-4 (KJV) And when he had opened THE SECOND SEAL, I heard the second beast say, Come and see.  
4 And there went out ANOTHER HORSE THAT WAS RED [the V. I. Lenin-led USSR]: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword.*

The Red Horse Rider is judged by the Black Horse Rider

*Revelation 6:5-6 (KJV) And when he had opened THE THIRD SEAL, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo A BLACK HORSE; and he that sat on him had A PAIR OF BALANCES IN HIS HAND. [December 10, 1991, was Black Horse Day, meaning that the Black Horse Rider U.S. defeated the Red Horse Rider USSR on that day. “Many were made white.”]*

*6 And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine.*
