#803 The Black Horse Rider – Sergeant York, the Black Horse



Key Understanding: *Reagan's black horse*. To illustrate President Ronald Reagan's prophetic role as a major Black Horse Rider of Revelation 6:5, the Lord ordained that a riderless black horse named Sergeant York serve as the most memorable image of the June 9, 2004, funeral of

President Ronald Reagan. The riderless horse, with Reagan's favorite riding boots reversed in the stirrups, symbolized the commander-in-chief as a fallen warrior. On June 5, Ronald Reagan had (symbolically) stopped riding the Black Horse, the Reagan-Bush era

having produced the result of the defeat of the Revelation 6:3-4 Red Horse Rider Soviet Union.

Revelation 6:5-6 (KJV) And when he had opened <u>THE THIRD SEAL</u>, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo <u>A BLACK HORSE</u>; and he [Ronald Reagan, who died on June 5, 2004, symbolically dismounting for the last time the black horse, Sergeant York] that sat on him had <u>A PAIR OF BALANCES IN HIS HAND</u>. [December 10, 1991, was Black Horse Day, meaning that the Black Horse Rider U.S. defeated the Red Horse Rider USSR on that day, during the administration of George H. W. Bush. "Many were made white."]
