## #818 The Black Horse Rider – The Black Horse represents Laodicea and Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; Smarty Jones, the horse from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

## **Smarty Jones** and **Philadelphia**, **Pennsylvania**:

- <u>Smarty Jones</u> was bred at Someday Farm near <u>Philadelphia</u>, <u>Pennsylvania</u>, by his owner, Roy Chapman.
- The trainer of **Smarty Jones**, John Servis, scored his first win in **Philadelphia**, and his stable was based there.
- <u>Smarty Jones</u> had training sessions at <u>Philadelphia Park</u> (one of Pennsylvania's four operating racetracks, at Bensalem, Bucks County, just outside of northeast Philadelphia) as a 2-year-old, and was injured there at the starting gate in July 2003 in preparation for his first career start.



The White Horse Riders and Philadelphia, Pa. In Unsealing #769, it was discussed that the spirit of Constantine, and of those with Constantine, represented the spirit of the Church of Laodicea, the Church of "People's Rights" (see also Unsealing #11 Six vs. Seven – The Declaration of Independence of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, can be seen in the Church of Laodicea).

This makes sense because the spirit of the church reigning on the earth with *sword*-bearing Constantine and the *Second* Rome Christian *Autocracy* carried through to the end of the *Third* 


Rome Romanov Christian *Autocracy*, and into the church reigning with Woodrow Wilson's *sword*-bearing *Fourth* Rome Christian *Democracy*. Essentially, the Constantinian spirit of the Church of Laodicea is equivalent to the Wilsonian spirit of the Church of Philadelphia, *Pennsylvania*.

Revelation 6:2 (KJV) And I saw, and behold <u>A WHITE HORSE</u>: and <u>HE</u> [Constantine the Great representing Second Rome Christian Autocracy, with the prophetic step to Woodrow Wilson representing Fourth Rome Christian Democracy] <u>THAT SAT ON HIM HAD A</u> <u>BOW</u> [represented by Sergeant York, the great American soldier hero of World War I]; and a crown was given unto him: and <u>HE WENT FORTH CONQUERING</u>, AND TO CONQUER.

Key Understanding: In the layered events of the fulfillment of prophecy, the White Horse Rider(s) of Revelation 6:1-2 and Black Horse Rider(s) of Revelation 6:5-6 are closely attached to the Church of Laodicea, the church of "people's rights," which is synonymous with the spirit and doctrines of the Church of Philadelphia, *Pennsylvania* (see Unsealing #10 Six vs. Seven – The Church of Laodicea, the Seven Church, is the Church of Philadelphia, *Pennsylvania*).

This is why Smarty Jones – "the people's horse," who is also symbolic of the Revelation 6:5-6 Black Horse and its rider – had roots closely tied to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, the city that represents the birth of democracy and "people's rights" in the United States. <u>In short, just as the White Horse Riders and Black Horse Riders are substantively tied to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, so too was Smarty Jones</u>.





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
