#829 Man o' War – Armies of Horsemen and Fours (4's)

Horsemen of War and Four. The previous Unsealing, titled Man o' War – The Fourth Rome Birth of Man o' War: Born March 29, 1917, four (4) days before Woodrow Wilson's April 2, 1917, War Message, clearly puts together the themes of (a) an "army of horsemen," represented by the horse Man o' War, and (b) the number "four".

Key Understanding: *Revelation 9:15*. The horse Man o' War prophetically linked (a) Woodrow Wilson and the Body of Americans as an "<u>army of horsemen</u>" with (b) the theme of "<u>four</u>".

Though we will not go deeper into it at the moment, now is a good time to note that the theme of an "<u>army of horsemen</u>" linked specifically with the number "<u>four</u>" happens to be prominent in scripture in the passage of Revelation 9:13-21, with the sounding of the Sixth Trumpet. There is a release of "<u>four</u> angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates" who had been prepared for (i) an hour, (ii) a day, (iii) a month, and (iv) a year – note the <u>four (4)</u> items of an hour, day, month, and year – all connected with an "<u>army of horsemen</u>" said to number 200,000,000. Clearly, (a) <u>Armies of Horsemen</u> and (b) <u>Four</u> go together.

The Army of the Horsemen and Four


Revelation 9:13-21 (KJV) And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,

14 Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the FOUR angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates.

15 And the FOUR angels were loosed, which were prepared for [i] an hour, and [ii] a day, and [iii] a month, and [iv] a year, for to slay the third part of men. 16 And the number of THE

ARMY OF THE HORSEMEN were two hundred thousand thousand: and I heard the number of them.

17 And thus I saw the horses in the vision, and them that sat on them, having breastplates of fire, and of jacinth, and




brimstone: and the heads of the horses were as the heads of lions; and out of their mouths issued fire and smoke and brimstone.

18 By these three was the third part of men killed, by the fire, and by the smoke, and by the brimstone, which issued out of their mouths.

19 For their power is in their mouth, and in their tails: for their tails were like unto serpents, and had heads, and with them they do hurt.

20 And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

21 Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts.
